Scope of Works

The Refurbishment of the Great Hall

The refurbishment restores many original features and styles such as oak paneling, joinery and the Kings crest, as well as paint and wood stain colours. Gold paint detail on the original column & lighting highlight the Grade I listed ceiling. Key features of the upgrade include:

- * Improved broadcasting capability with built-in infrastructure.
- * Improved acoustics for events and media. This includes acoustic door seals, absorption material behind wall paneling and the placement of the air handling unit.
- * New square track LED up/down lighting system which echos the original ceiling and provides appropriate lighting for exams as well as events.
- * Spot-lights and colour feature lighting on walls for accent options for events.
- * New IT, AV (including wall speakers) and electrical services and pipework cleverly concealed in the restored European Oak wall paneling.
- * Upgraded AV and control centre with flexibility to support the hall's many types of events. This includes full HD front projection system, new projection screen, voice reinforcement system, lectern, induction loop system, hand held and radio lapel microphones, portable tablet device input connectivity, touch panel controls and more.
- * Upgraded fire safety features.
- * WiFi for 600 devices.

Works completed last year included lighting repairs and improvements, refurbishment and repairs to the Grade I listed windows.
